All patients begin with a thorough evaluation to determine their specific rehab needs. This may range from a single modality treatment to a full rehab program.



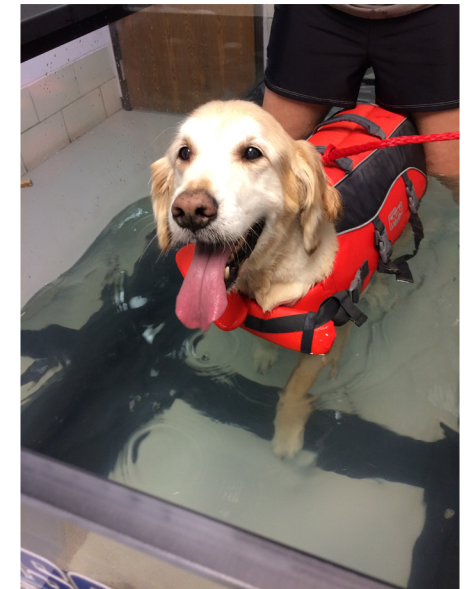
Team Approach

Physical Rehabilitation is the treatment of injury and illness to decrease pain and restore function.

Physical rehabilitation can be used to help many conditions in pets. Some commonly treated conditions are:
Post-op recovery
Osteoarthritis
InterVertebral Disc Disease
Degenerative diseases
Injury or illness recovery
Congenital deformity
Weight loss
Athletic conditioning



Therapeutic Exercise

Therapeutic exercise is used to target specific muscle groups to build muscle mass, strength and coordination. Home exercise is an important component of rehab. Most pets will be given a list of home activities to augment rehabilitation sessions.

Underwater Treadmill and Hydrotherapy

Our underwater treadmill allows us to tailor exercise to very low impact/low joint stress to very high intensity workouts. High water levels support weight, relieving pressure on joints to help improve mobility and proprioception. Low water allows for resistance for muscle building. Treadmills increase the extension of the gait to improve range of motion and help with overall conditioning. Therapeutic jets help improve circulation and massage muscles after workouts.



Modalities

We use modalities to help decrease pain and inflammation, improve range of motion and speed tissue healing. We offer:
Class IV Laser Therapy
Electrical Stimulation
Neuromuscular Stimulation
Iontophoresis
Phonophoresis
Therapeutic Ultrasound
Cryotherapy
Kinesiology Taping



Orthotics and Prosthetics

Veterinary Orthotics and Prosthetics (V-OP) are used to recreate or maintain proper limb alignment and use following deformity, injury or amputation. They can range from a soft support wrap to rigid/articulated prosthetic limbs.
